

DETERMINING BEST FIT



Alignment

- Know the mission of the agency and what it is mandated to fund
- 2. Determine the agencies priorities
 - a. Look at the RFPs from the last couple of years (what do they say are their priorities?)
 - b. See what they have funded in the last couple of years
- 3. Address a need relevant to agency's mission/priorities and develop a potential solution
- 4. Talk with a program officer
