# Reducing Barriers: OSU Approval Process for Restricted Data Sets

- Regardless of college, the **ONLY** person with the power to sign on behalf of the university is Geoff Chatas so... how to get his signature?
- In EHE, start with your fiscal person – the request goes through the EHE contract process with one special addition – the EHE CIO has to sign off as well
- Other colleges – start with your Office of Research



# Reducing Barriers: Creating and Managing the Required Facilities

- Have conversations with your Chair, college CIO and Facilities planner early and often
- Have the required space in place so it can be entered onto the ePA-005
- Add the costs for the development/maintenance of the space to the budget and justification



# Reducing Barriers: Talk to the Experts

- Experts are the researchers that have figured out how to manage all the systems
- RMC and EHE Office of Research have a list of those researchers who are working on public and restricted data sets – contact us to find other people that are working on the sets that you are interested in
